people.**




Hey! What do you think your doing!

mistreat people.





But one day, when the bus was filling up. The bus driver told me to move myself to another seat to let a white man sit there.




But you know what I did? I **Defiantly** said no! because I didn't think it's fair that I had to give up my seat because I'm African American!



But no adventure can last forever, you better wake up and win the freedom for African Americans.



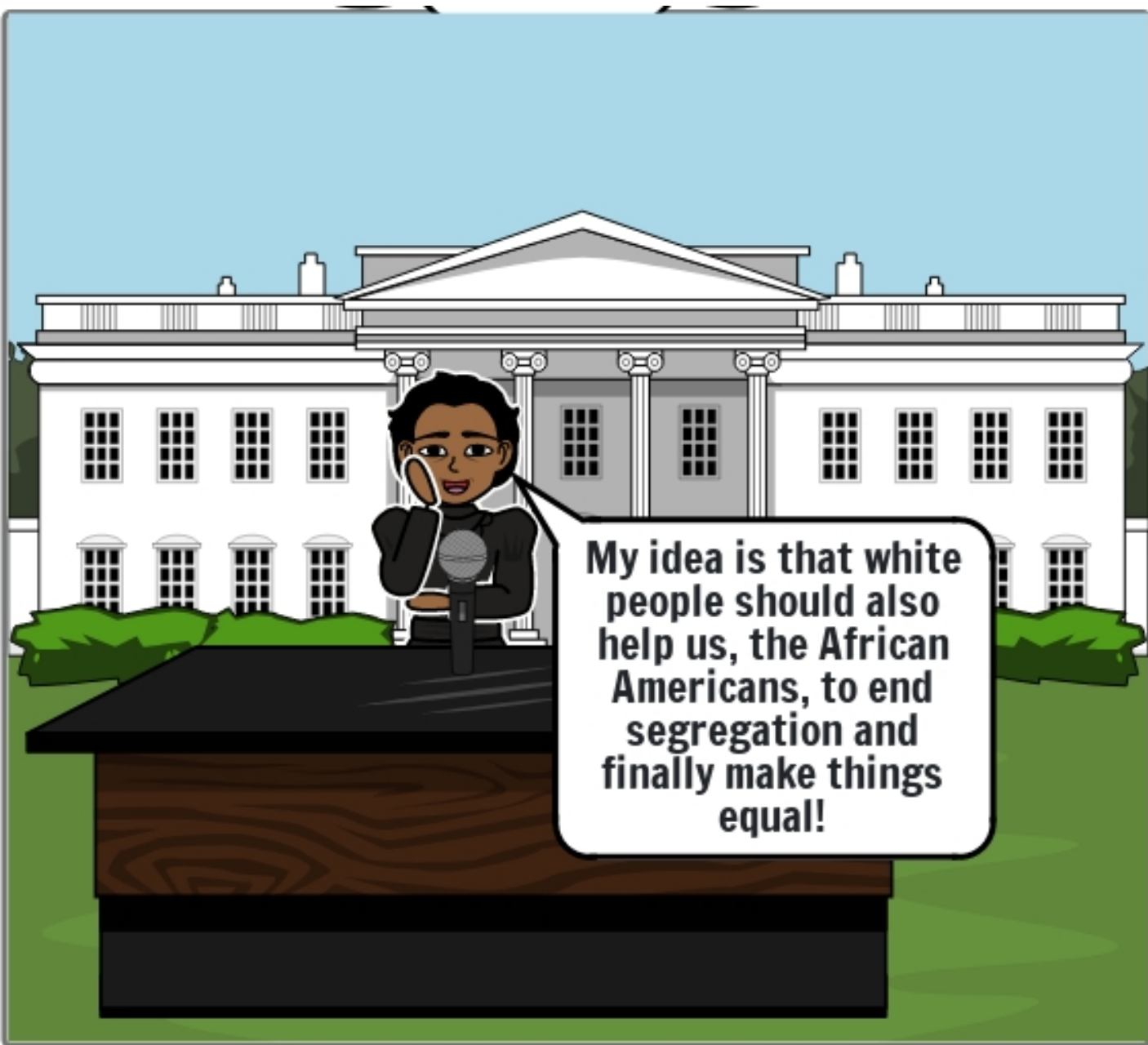




At the white house. . .
